### **High School IT Specialist Certificate**

After High School Graduation

Following a minimum of 240 experience hours at the site of the business partner the summer after graduation, a certificate is awarded to a student if they have completed steps 1, 2, and 3 as described. Completion of this certificate would be recognized by businesses and open doors for students to continue on an IT career pathway.

## Step 2

### **Mentoring and Work Based Learning**

During 12th Grade

During the 12th grade year, students would be assigned projects from a business partner. This application-based work would average between 10-15 hours per week and would be guided by a mentor at the business. The work should result in a product that has value to the partner business. These experiences would ideally be completed with the same cohort as step 2.

# Step 1 Summer after 11th Grade

### **Summer Intensive Training and Experience Hours**

Students in this pathway would attend a two-week intensive training program at Central College at the beginning of the summer following their 11th grade year. This would be followed by a minimum of 240 experience hours to be completed with a cohort at the site of the business partner. The experiences could vary but they should have connections to the foundational skills that are needed for the certificate in step 4.

Program Pre-requisites

Students realize an interest in IT and related skills. The required course is outlined in Step 1 above. Program entry is pending an interview with employers and the number of employment openings.
